

CONTROVERSY

There is a lot of controversy around the museum, including that:

- It was named after people who participated in colonization
- Much of the art at the museum was collected during colonization
 - Namibia ivory, traditional clothing
 - Cameroon wooden figures, masks
- Collectors only wanted art that was representative of pure and natural cultures, not those tainted by the colonization of other countries
- Promotes colonialism, capitalism, and eurocentricity
