Who were the Stasi?

Est 8. Feb 1950

Formally known as the Ministerium für Staatssicherheit, the Stasi were the secret police for the Socialist Party of the German Democratic Republic (GDR) until they were overthrown by demonstrators in 1990.

Espionage

The Stasi were tasked with gathering domestic and foreign intelligence, focusing heavily on West Germany. They are widely regarded as having some of the most intense and thorough surveillance in history.
