Daytheon Sturges has been a physician assistant (PA) since 2008 and a PA educator since 2013. He is an assistant professor of family medicine at the University of Washington – MEDEX Northwest PA program, associate program director of regional affairs, justice, equity, diversity, & inclusion, and also serves as the justice, equity, diversity, and inclusion co-chair for the Department of Family Medicine, while maintaining clinical practice in family medicine UW Neighborhood Clinic - Northgate. His passion is providing care to underserved populations. He serves as the chair of the Physician Assistant Education's Diversity and Inclusion Mission Advancement Commission, as a Faculty Skills 101 Workshop facilitator, and as the JEDI feature editor for the Journal of Physician Assistant Education. He is currently a Ph.D. candidate in health studies at Texas Woman's University, where he also completed a post-master's certificate in interprofessional informatics. His dissertation studied perceived burnout in underrepresented minority PA educators in the United States in order to inform future health interventions. He will tentatively defend his research findings June 2021.
